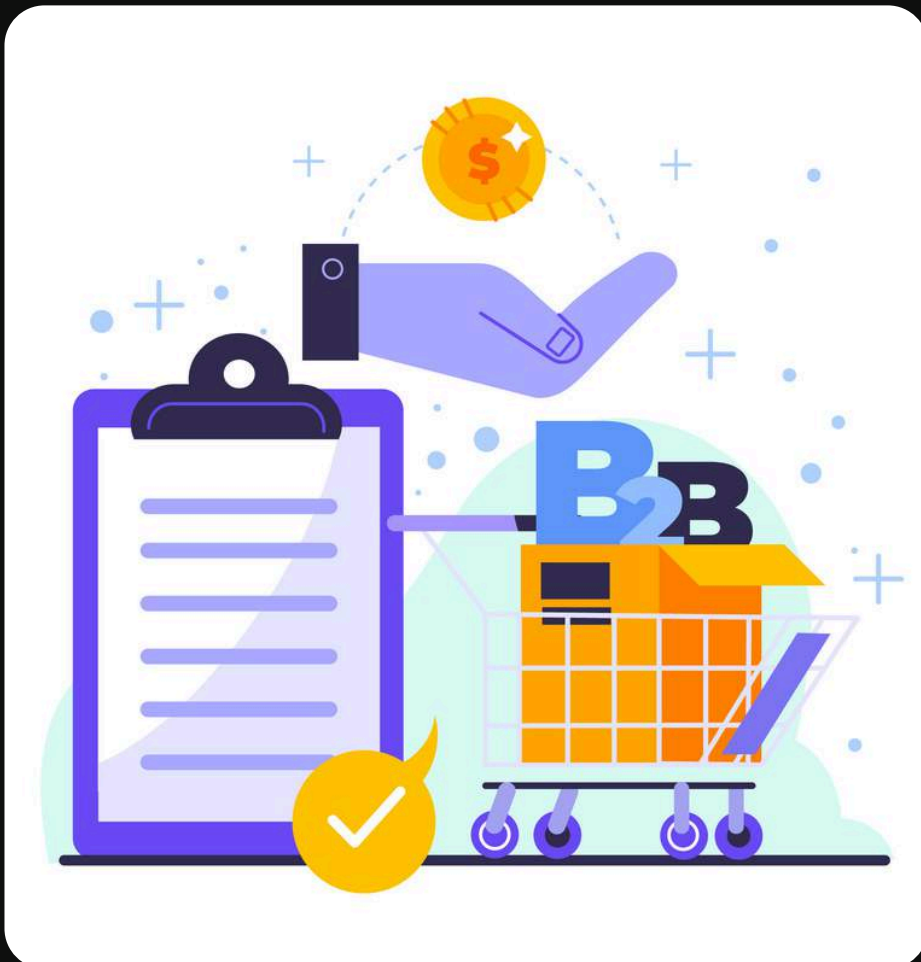

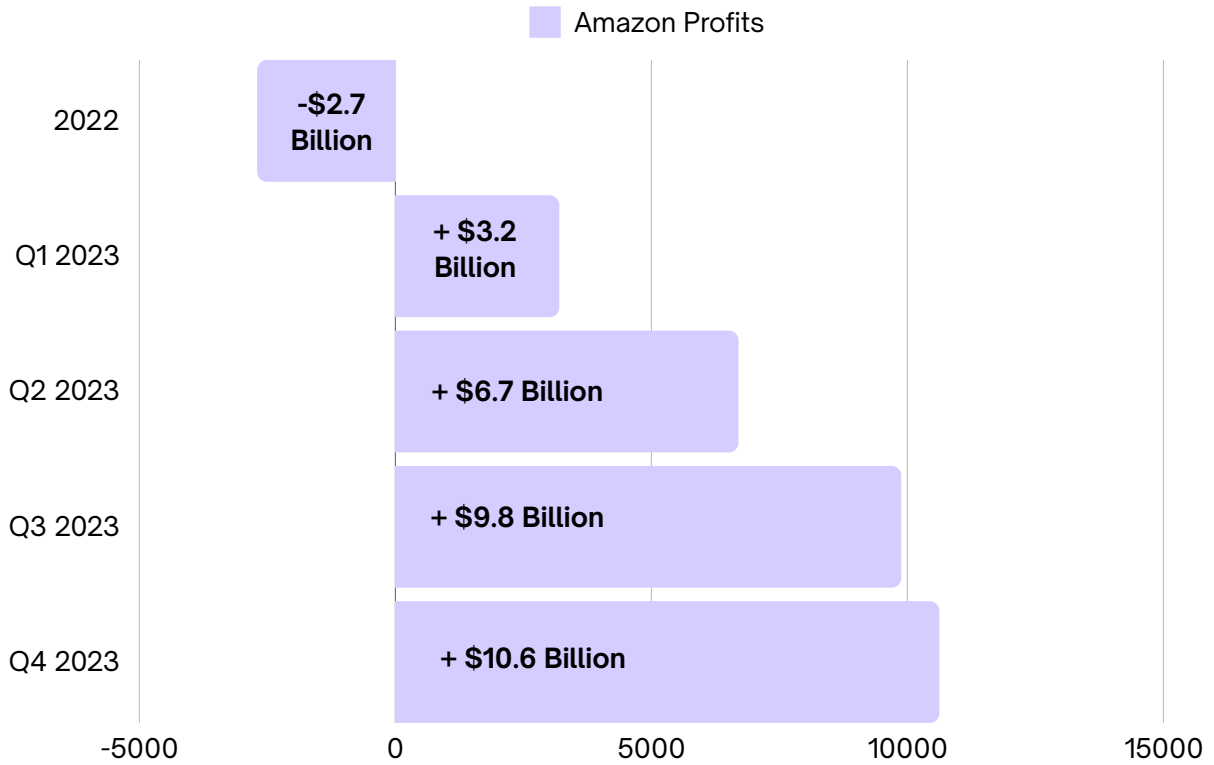

Background



2022

The global COVID-19 pandemic heavily impacted most industries, and e-commerce was no exception. Although Amazon initially experienced a positive trend in the early days of the pandemic due to increased demand for online shopping, the company's numbers were affected when physical stores reopened in March 2022. As a result, Amazon incurred a \$2.7 billion loss in 2022, marking the biggest loss in the company's history.

2023

After suffering billions in losses in 2023, Amazon began seeking ways to recover, introducing new fees such as expanded size tiers with increased charges, per-cubic-square-foot storage fees, higher fulfillment fees, increased referral fees, and more.

Additionally, Amazon raised rates on premium ad spots, charging sellers nearly

50% more for advertising.

As we entered 2024, Amazon has already implemented new fees and raised existing ones. While these fees may appear insignificant individually, their cumulative impact could be detrimental to sellers.

Impact On Sellers

Amazon has been exploring new strategies to rebound from the substantial losses incurred in 2022, with **profound implications for its seller community**.

In **2023**, it implemented various measures such as **revised size tiers** with heightened fees, **per-cubic-square-foot storage** charges, and **increased fulfillment** and **referral fees** to bolster its recovery efforts.

Now, in **2024**, Amazon has introduced **additional fees** that collectively pose significant financial challenges for its sellers.

FBA Fees Overview

Inbound Placement Fee

This will be applied to standard and large-sized products to reflect the cost of distributing inventory to fulfillment centers close to customers.

FBA Fulfillment Fee Rates

On average, FBA fulfillment fee rates will decrease by \$0.20 per unit for standard-sized products and by \$0.61 per unit for Large Bulky-sized products.

Return Processing Fee:

This fee will apply to products with return rates exceeding a specific threshold for their category.

Non-Peak Monthly Storage Fees

Vendors exceeding a 22-week ratio will incur the fee, except for items stored for 0-30 days or certain products such as clothing, shoes, and bags.

Low Inventory Level Fees

If both short-term (the last 30 days) and long-term (the last 90 days) supply levels fall below 28 days, sellers will be charged the low inventory-level fee.

Referral Fees for Apparel Products

This fee will be reduced, although the reduction will depend on the items' pricing. Other referral fees will remain unchanged.

Multi-Channel Fulfillment Fees

If sellers opt to use Amazon's services to deliver a product sold on another platform, they'll face charges for multi-channel fulfillment from Amazon.

Removal & Disposal Fees

Sellers who use Amazon's FBA service can access Amazon's removal, disposal, and liquidation options to manage inventory they're struggling to sell.

Aged Inventory Surcharge Fees

This fee is applied to inventory that has been stored in Amazon's fulfillment centers for long periods.

The Amazon FBA service enables sellers to store their merchandise in Amazon's fulfillment centers, while Amazon handles shipping, customer service, and returns on their behalf. In return for this service, Amazon imposes fulfillment fees on the sellers.

Amazon's fulfillment fees vary based on factors such as the item's category, size, and billable weight. **Amazon will change FBA Fulfillment fees for 2024.**

These changes will be implemented in two stages, with adjustments to FBA Fee Rates scheduled for

February 5th



April 15th



The initial phase will introduce the new granular tiers, followed by a second phase entailing a general fee reduction averaging 4% across size tiers.

Among these tiers, the **"Large standard 4 oz or less"** tier will experience the most **significant reduction at 5%**, while the **"Large standard 2.75+ to 3lb"** tier will see the **smallest reduction at 3%**.

On average, Amazon will decrease FBA fulfillment fee rates by:

The most significant change this year regarding the Amazon FBA Fulfillment Fee involves a more detailed classification of the FBA Size Tiers. This refined tier system, which is more granular in nature, will particularly benefit sellers who previously fell at the lower end of a specific size tier.

Although FBA fulfillment fee rates will be decreased, Amazon will start applying new fees to Amazon sellers, which indicates that the overall cost will be higher.

By reducing product weight and shifting each item into a lower size and weight tier, you can significantly cut down on FBA fulfillment fees.

This strategic adjustment can lead to substantial savings for your business.

Amazon will implement a new low-inventory level fulfillment fee starting April 1, 2024. It's crucial to recognize that this fee pertains to fulfillment, not storage.

This fee will be applied to standard-sized products experiencing consistently low stock levels over time, based on historical demand.

If both short-term (the last 30 days) and long-term (the last 90 days) supply levels fall below 28 days, sellers will be charged the low inventory-level fee.

This fee targets standard-sized products with consistently low inventory levels relative to unit sales, impacting Amazon's distribution capabilities and increasing shipping costs due to the need for expedited shipping, particularly across long distances.

The less inventory a seller maintains, the higher the fulfillment fees, aiming to offset Amazon's distribution expenses.

It's important to note that this fee will be added on top of existing fulfillment fees

There are two effective ways to overcome FBA low inventory level fees:

- 1. Connect Forceget with Your Amazon Seller Central Account:** Receive notifications whenever your inventory reaches risky levels that could lead to high fees.
- 2. Use Forceget Warehouses:** Store your products in Forceget warehouses to avoid dealing with low inventory level fees entirely.

Additionally, sellers will only be charged the low-inventory-level fee once they sell the last units in their inventory, not upon complete depletion.

The low-inventory level fee will NOT be applied in the following cases:

- New professional sellers will be exempt from this fee for the initial 365 days following their first inventory-received date.
- Newly introduced parent products to FBA will not be subjected to this fee for the initial 180 days from their first inventory-received date. This exemption specifically applies to sellers enrolled in FBA New Selection.
- Products automatically replenished by Amazon Warehousing and Distribution will also be spared from this fee, as Amazon manages the replenishment process on behalf of sellers.

If sellers utilize Amazon's services to fulfill a product sold on a different platform, they will incur [Amazon multi-channel fulfillment](#) fees.

Amazon initially attempted to disincentivize sellers from selling products on other platforms by making it less profitable for Amazon sellers. However, Amazon's approach has changed.

In 2023, Amazon launched a program with Shopify, allowing customers to "Buy with Prime" directly from a Shopify store. This collaboration represents one of the first and largest partnerships Amazon has initiated with other marketplaces.

Amazon increased the Multi-channel Fulfillment (MCF) fees on February 5, 2024. On average, the fees will increase by 3.5% across all delivery speed options. If the shipping weight is less than one pound, the MCF fee will remain the same.

Amazon has introduced a new fee, the Inbound Placement Fee, which will be applied starting on March 1, 2024. The purpose behind this cost is to distribute inventory expenses across Amazon's fulfillment network.

There are two types of service available:

Premium Service

Your shipping plan is sent to a single Receive Center or Fulfillment Center, where Amazon will take care of distributing your inventory across its network. The fee for this service may vary based on where you're shipping from, with higher fees for shipments going to locations in the West compared to other parts of the country.

Discounted Service

With this option, you can handle sending your inventory to multiple locations yourself, either at a reduced fee or for free. The discount you receive will depend on factors such as the number of shipments and the specific locations you're sending your inventory to. Just keep in mind that in some cases, this discounted service might not be available.

The fees will average **\$0.27 per unit for standard-sized products** and **\$1.58 per unit for Large Bulky-sized products**. Amazon sellers will be billed for these fees 45 days after their products are received at Amazon's initial receiving center.

Amazon started implementing a fee to cover their costs for distributing inventory from one fulfillment center to another. The product types and quantities, existing inventory levels across the network, and location of customer demand all influence the cost. Also, the shipping time is not certain, nor is the process visible.

The Solution?

Forceget offers 3PL Warehouse services, helping you distribute your inventory to warehouses closer to customer demand, without charging additional costs for the allocation of inventory.

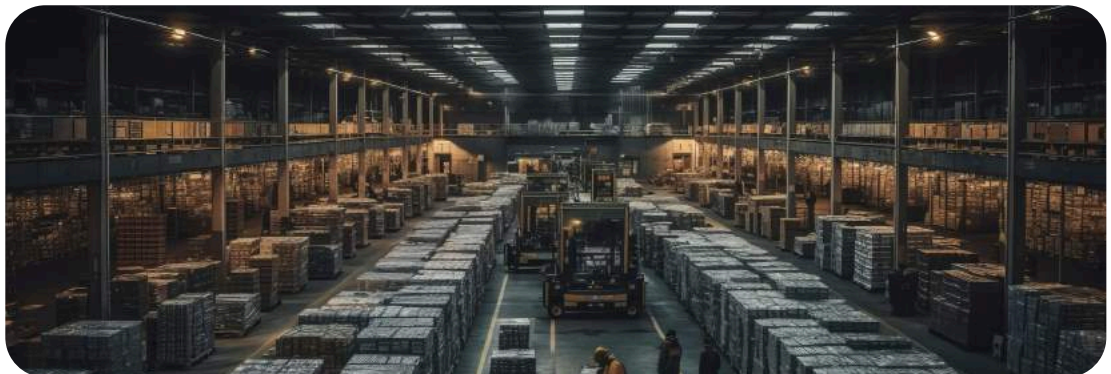

Placement Fee Audit

The Forceget operations team conducted a placement fee audit for a customer to identify the most cost-effective strategy for distributing 15 pallets of gift boxes. After a thorough data analysis, it was determined that the most economical option was to distribute the pallets across five different locations. Conversely, the analysis revealed that sending all pallets to a single location resulted in the highest costs. This strategic approach allowed the customer to optimize their distribution expenses significantly.

Amazon's removal, disposal, and liquidation services are available to sellers utilizing Amazon's FBA service to get rid of inventory that they are having problems selling.

The purpose of these services is to avoid excess storage fees.

Removal Service

Removal services allow sellers to collect their inventory back from Amazon's warehouses.

Disposal Service

Disposal services make Amazon responsible for disposing the inventory.

Liquidation Service

Liquidation services offer sellers the chance to sell the remaining inventory to liquidators for a fee in order to recoup some of the costs.



While **liquidation fees will stay consistent in 2024**, ranging from approximately \$0.25 to \$0.40 based on the item's price, **removal and disposal fees are expected to increase**.

From February 5, 2024, sellers should anticipate a rise in these fees across all size tiers and be ready to manage accordingly.

In 2023, this fee was applicable to professional sellers with a storage utilization ratio exceeding 26 weeks.

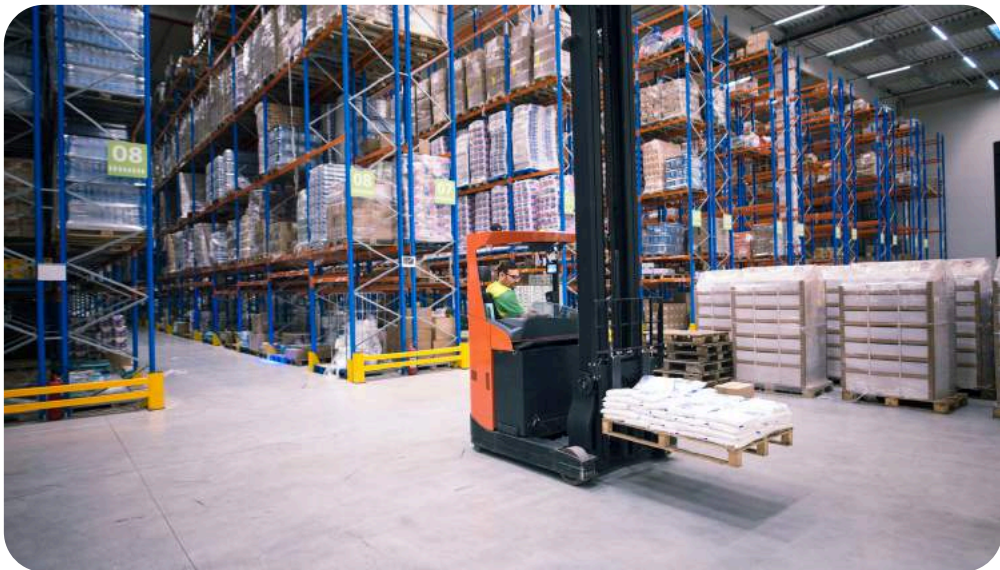
By June 2024, **sellers with a ratio surpassing 22 weeks will face the fee**—except for inventory stored for 0-30 days or specific products like clothing, shoes, and bags.

If the conditions are met, **the additional charge is combined with the base monthly storage fee** and any accrued aged inventory fees, resulting in increased total monthly storage costs.

Furthermore, Amazon is introducing more detailed tiers for this charge, aligning with their broader initiative to pinpoint costs more precisely.

Commencing **April 1, 2024**, sellers will benefit from a **reduced base storage utilization fee** for standard-sized items during non-peak periods, dropping from \$0.87 to \$0.78.

Fees fluctuate between non-peak and peak seasons and are contingent upon the storage utilization ratio and the size of the item.

Result:

With some fulfillment fees decreasing in 2024, maintaining an inventory age under 90 days and over 28 days of supply can result in substantial savings.

In 2023, this management approach would yield a \$10.01 profit for this product, a 33% margin, which is less than the potential savings in 2024.

The fee changes allow for greater savings by avoiding surcharges on aged inventory and low supply days.
